

State Report Card 1-Pager Overview

What is the State Report Card?

The Tennessee State Report Card is a one-stop shop to find information on how Tennessee districts and schools are performing across the state. It's an important tool released each year to help parents and families, educators, elected officials, community members, and other education stakeholders understand how Tennessee's schools and districts are performing and serving our students.

The State Report Card includes:

- Dashboard of detailed, easy-to-understand information about school and district performance including School Letter Grades, student achievement, growth, English learners' proficiency in English, graduation rates, and postsecondary readiness.
- Information about student enrollment, staff information, discipline, and school and district funding.
- State-level data is provided as a reference to understand how schools and districts are performing in comparison with others across the state.

What are School Letter Grades?

School Letter Grades are calculated using the following performance metrics:

- ▶ Achievement
- ▶ Growth
- ▶ Growth for Highest Need Students
- ▶ College and Career Readiness

The **TISA Calculator** is a tool designed to estimate how much funding individual students can generate under the new TISA funding formula to address individual student needs.

A **Compare Tool** is a tool designed for users to compare schools and districts side-by-side on multiple metrics: school or district characteristics, demographics, academic achievement, available programs, and financial information.
